Transportation We fly JAL or ANA unless specifically notified. Ground for this tour is by bus & shinkansen.

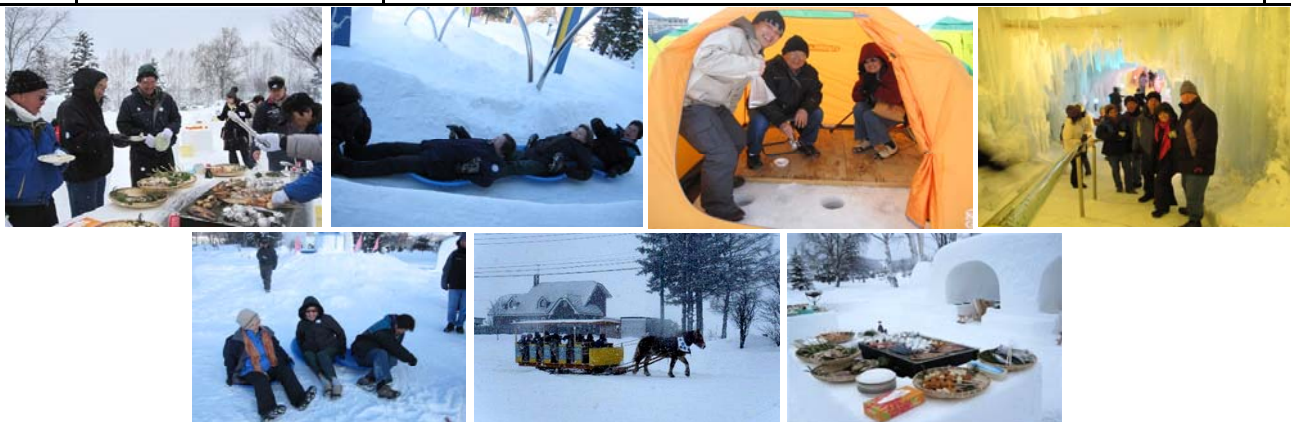
Meals All meals, except for any 'meal on own' at places where people generally want to shop/browse on own.
